Nestled at Caphouse Colliery, the National Coal Mining Museum for England offers a picturesque, rural setting on the western edge of the Yorkshire coalfield, a place with centuries of mining history. It boasts the only coal-mine shaft still in everyday use in England today.

Our conference facilities are designed to offer the maximum flexibility. The Caphouse Suite can be configured as one large suite to seat up to 150 delegates in theatre style, or divided into three smaller spaces or two combined units, depending upon your needs.

Every tour 'darn pit' is led by a charismatic former miner with extensive experience underground. They'll guide you through 180 years of mining history, explaining the tools and techniques used. The standard tour lasts approximately 1 hour and 20 minutes but can be shortened to an hour fit your schedule. Each tour can accommodate up to 15 delegates due to lift size, with additional tours available at 10-15 minute intervals (subject to availability and prior booking).
